Counselors In Classrooms for ECAP

On February 4th & 5th, Counselors will be in *all* Junior English classes to go over Resume writing with our Juniors. We will be utilizing AZCIS as our online platform to maintain student portfolios. This resource allows for student to update their resumes as the living document that they are as they continue to get involved in new leadership activities, jobs, or other relevant experience throughout their high school career.

Often, College and Universities allow students to add their high school resume to their application and/or admissions packet. These can also be used for future job searches.

Additionally, NPA Counselors will be in all Junior History class the following week to discuss college planning and to show students how to use AZCIS and other online resources to conduct a college search comparing and contrasting a multitude of different aspects of a school: financial, programs offered, etc.



Counselors will continue to go into classrooms for each grade 8-10th, in order to meet ECAP (Education Career Action Plan) goals.

Topics will include:

- Four year plan and graduation requirements
- Career Inventory/Interest Profiler
- Reality Check (finances)
- Introduction to resumes
