Comments on average salary calculation (optional): This represents the avg. base salary for instructional staff and does not include amounts for additional duties or CSF 301 performance pay. Returning teachers are receiving an increase of 8% in base plus a \$2000 increase in base from funds previously included within performance pay. Teachers will still receive some performance pay. Staff changes have resulted in different salaries for replacement teachers; thus, the overall salary increase is only marginally above 8.0%.
